Pork Rib Cook-Off

TO ALL INTERESTED COOKS:

We wish to extend an invitation for you to join in our 34th Annual Pork Rib Cook-Off, which will be April 11, 2026, during Hogskin Holidays Festival.

We are enclosing, with this letter, an entry form, statement of liability, list of prizes and rules and regulations for the cook-off. Please take a few minutes to read these forms and complete them.

Contestants may begin setting up at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2026.

Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m. we will have our contestants meeting.

As in past years, you will again be able to sell barbecue by the pound; as well as sell food to eat on the premises. If you desire to have a food concession, please mark it on the application/entry form.

In addition to the Pork Ribs category, competitors may also enter the "Anything But" and Dessert categories. A single flat entry fee of \$150 covers participation in all categories.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Contestants may enter and compete in one or all categories.

There will be blind judging by qualified judges. There will be a brief explanation of judging procedures at the contestants meeting.

(1) There will be two on site categories in the Hogskin Holidays Pork Cook-Off: Pork Ribs and "Anything But". Meat for the contest may not be precooked, sauced, injected, marinated, or cured in any way prior to inspection at the beginning of the contest.

a. A PORK RIB ENTRY IS DEFINED AS PORTIONS OF THE HOG WHICH INCLUDE THE RIBS. You must turn in a minimum of 8 (1 per judge) or up to 16 (2 per judge)

b. "ANYTHING BUT" ENTRY IS DEFINED AS YOUR CHOICE OF FAVORITE GRILLED RECIPE. THIS ENTRY CAN BE ANYTHING BUT PORK RIBS, AS LONG AS IT IS COOKED ON THE PREMISES ON THE GRILL.

(2) Each contestant competing shall supply all of their own meat, cooking ingredients, individual cooking utensils, preparation tables, etc. Provided to the contestants are a regulation cooking area and necessary sanitary facilities. If a larger area is needed, special arrangements can be made by contacting the sponsor. All contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes by the city, county, state, or federal codes.

(3) Contestants may begin setting up at 3:00 p.m., Friday, prior to the cook-off on Saturday.

(4) All meat must be inspected before cooking by a cook-off committee member. After the meat is inspected, you may marinate and begin cooking the meat.

(5) Each contestant must cook enough meat to provide the required samples for judging.

- a. The Cook-off Committee will provide containers that will be turned in to the judges for the Rib, Anything But, and sauce competitions. If any other container is turned in, then it will be disqualified.
- b. All of the containers will be exactly the same and will not be numbered for any of the competitions.

Butch Hedger “Anything But” Competition

8 containers must be turned in for this competition. It is your responsibility to put your number on the inside of each container. This is to be turned in at 12 PM. You can turn in 5 minutes before 12 PM or 5 minutes after 12 PM.

Dessert Competition

If you are entering this competition, you must turn in 4 EA individual servings in 4 containers. If you use your own container, it is your responsibility to put your number on the container where it isn't visible until opened by the judges. This is to be turned in at 12 PM. You can turn in 5 minutes before 12 PM or 5 minutes after 12 PM.

Rib Competition

8 containers must be turned in for this competition. It is your responsibility to put your number on the inside of each container. Green leafy lettuce is the only garnish that can be used and this is optional, not required. This is to be turned in at 1 PM. You can turn in 5 minutes before 1 PM or 5 minutes after 1 PM.

Sauce Competition

If you are entering this competition, you must turn in 8 EA individual servings in the provided containers. This is to be turned in at 1 PM. You can turn in 5 minutes before 1 PM or 5 minutes after 1 PM.

(6) A single flat entry fee of \$150 covers participation in all categories. The selection committee reserves the right to reject any application. If your application is not accepted, your fees will be refunded by mail. No refunds of the application fees will be made once you have been accepted in the contest, whether you appear or not. (7) A meeting for all contestants will be held Saturday at 8:00 a.m. The rules, regulations and other necessary information will be discussed at that time.

(8) It is the responsibility of each contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned following the contest. It is imperative that our clean-up be thorough. Any space left in disarray or with loose trash and garbage will disqualify the team from future participation. Trash receptacles will be supplied

(9) The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guests. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed (given away or sold) to the general public by contestants.

(10) The barbecue committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situation warrants.

(11) Decisions of the barbecue committee chairman and judges are final.

(12) Violation of Rules and Regulations of the contest may result in disqualification, expulsion from the grounds, and/or disqualification from future participation.
