STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

As Chief Cook and a Contestant in the Hogskin Holidays Cook-Off, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Hogskin Holidays Cook-Off Committee and sponsors (HHCO), its employees and volunteers, from any and all claims made against HHCO, including without limitation, all costs, liabilities, judgments, expenses, damages, or reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or in connection with:

- (1) any structure erected by contestant;
- (2) any apparatus, equipment, or personal property used by contestant;
- (3) any act or omission to act of contestant, its agents, invitees, participants, representatives, employees, servants and agents; and,
- (4) any claims made on accounts of, or resulting from, contestant's participation in this contest.

I further certify that I have read and understood all the rules and regulations associated with this contest. I understand that failure to comply with these rules will result in my disqualification from the contest.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- (1.) There will be two on site categories in the Hogskin Holidays Pork Cook-Off: Pork Ribs and "Anything But". Meat for the contest may not be precooked, sauced, injected, marinated, or cured in any way prior to inspection at the beginning of the contest.
 - a. -A PORK RIB ENTRY IS DEFINED AS PORTIONS OF THE HOG WHICH INCLUDE THE RIBS.
 - b. -"ANYTHING BUT" ENTRY IS DEFINED AS YOUR CHOICE OF FAVORITE GRILLED RECIPE. THIS ENTRY CAN BE ANYTHING BUT PORK RIBS, AS LONG AS IT IS COOKED ON THE PREMISES ON THE GRILL.
- (2.) Each contestant competing shall supply all of their own meat, cooking ingredients, individual cooking utensils, preparation tables, etc. Provided to the contestants are a regulation cooking area and necessary sanitary facilities. If a larger area is needed, special arrangements can be made by contacting the sponsor. All contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes by the city, county, state, or federal codes.
- (3.) Contestants may begin setting up at 11:00 AM, Friday, prior to the cook-off on Saturday.
- (4.) All meat must be inspected before cooking by a cook-off committee member. After the meat is inspected, you may marinate and begin cooking the meat.
- (5.) Each contestant must cook enough meat to provide the required samples for judging. The entries must be in pre-numbered Styrofoam boxes provided by the committee. You must have 8 (eight) separate pieces of ribs in the turn-in box. Garnish is optional and limited to leafy green lettuce. No decorations. Some will choose to enter 8 (eight) one bone ribs. But you can put in 8 (eight) two-bone ribs in the turn-in box. Eight pre-numbered boxes will be provided to each cooking team for the "Anything but.." competition. You must provide 8 (eight) individual servings of your "Anything but..." entry. Small containers will be provided for the sauce competition. Eight (8) individual servings of your dessert must be provided in a container of your choice.
- (6.) The judging of the ribs and sauce begins at 1:00 p.m. Saturday. You will have five (5) minutes before and five (5) minutes after the turn-in time to turn in your entries to the judges. The judging of "Anything But..." and dessert entries begins at 12:00 p.m. (noon), a cook-off committee member will come by and remind you of the time approximately 10 minutes prior to turn in time of each event.

- (7.) The team number used for judging will be assigned to you and marked on the turn-in boxes by the cook-off committee.
- (8.) There will be blind judging by qualified judges. There will be a brief explanation of judging procedures at the contestants meeting.
- (9.) Contestants may enter and compete in one or all categories. However, you must compete in the pork rib cook-off in order to participate in the "anything but" competition. Competition in both categories qualifies you to compete in desserts.
- (10.) Application Fees are based on category entered. The fees are \$100 for the rib category and \$50 for the "Anything but" category. The selection committee reserves the right to reject any application. If your application is not accepted, your fees will be refunded by mail. No refunds of the application fees will be made once you have been accepted in the contest, whether you appear or not. All checks should be made to Hogskin Holidays Cook-Off. - (11.) A meeting for all contestants will be held Friday, following the contestant supper. The rules, regulations and other necessary information will be discussed at that time.
- (12.) It is the responsibility of each contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned following the contest. It is imperative that our clean up be thorough. Any space left in disarray or with loose trash and garbage will disqualify the team from future participation. Trash receptacles will be supplied.
- (13.) The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guests. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed (given away or sold) to the general public by contestants.
- (14.) The barbecue committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situation warrants.
- (15.) Decisions of the barbecue committee chairman and judges are final.
- (16.) Violation of Rules and Regulations of the contest may result in disqualification, expulsion from the grounds, and/or disqualification from future participation.
